GENERAL RULES

1. Tennis courts are available **DAILY** on a first come basis. Follow procedures established in our **Tennis Courts Sign-In Procedures and Conduct Violations** to reserve a Tennis Court.

2. Tennis Club events sponsored by the SCPDTC Board take priority over open play. Notice of reservations and events are posted on the monitor in the window at Building D. The CourtReserve app on devices also shows tennis court reservations, should the monitor be unavailable.
3. Doubles games do not take precedence over singles games.

4. Only residents and their guests may use the Tennis courts. All Residents must have their Resident ID Card or a copy of it in their possession. Guests, 18 years or younger, must be accompanied by the host Resident always. Guests, older than 18 years of age must have a valid guest card provided by the Fitness Center unless they are accompanied by a host resident. Guests may be asked to relinquish the use of a court when all such courts are in use and residents are waiting.
5. All players must wear proper Tennis attire while on the courts. This includes t-shirts, Polo shirts, shorts, sweat suits, or other appropriate athletic clothing and footwear. Tennis shoes with **NON-MARKING SOLES** are mandatory.

6. Tennis lessons between **November 1st and April 30th** are allowed only **after 10:30 am**. From **May 1st until October 31th** lessons may begin **after 9:00 am**. The instructor must be present with a Sun City resident to utilize court time. The resident or instructor must reserve a court available on the Court Reserve System.
7. Use of the Ball Machines between **November 1st and April 30th** is allowed **after 10:30 am**. From **May 1st and October 31th**, use may begin **after 9:00 am**. The ball machines can be used only in courts 3, 4 and 6 and 7.

8. To use the Ball Machines, you need to be member of the SCPD Tennis Club and must be properly certified by the people designated by the SCPDTC for that purpose.

9. Beverages in closed containers are allowed on the courts. No glass.

10. No pets are allowed on or around the courts or BLDG "D" patio area at any time as indicated by the posted signs unless it is a service dog.

11. Tennis courts are for playing Tennis only. **No roller skates, "heelies", roller blades, scooters, skateboards, bicycles or remote-control cars**, etc. are allowed on court surfaces or the surrounding area at any time.

12. If there is any debris or water on the court, do not begin playing until the debris and/or water are removed.

13. All members and their guests using the courts do so at their own risk. Neither the Association nor its manager shall be responsible for injuries or accidents following the terms specified in the waiver signed by each member when they joined the SCPDTC and signed the membership application.

14. In the event of a medical emergency at the SCPD Tennis Club Facility (Building "D", Tennis Courts), press the emergency button next to the men's restroom. Subsequently, call the **SCPDCA Community Patrol's Main Gate at 760 360-6026** and make them aware of the emergency, While you can use your cell phone, the connection at Building D goes directly to dispatch and they know your location.

15. The defibrillator unit it is located inside the Women's bathroom in Bldg. "D" and **it must only be operated by people trained in the use of the device.**
